## SENIORITY RULES FOR AMU SCHOOL TEACHERS:

 Seniority of a teacher of university school in a grade (i.e. PGT/TGT/PRT) shall be determined from the date of 1st continuous appointment in that grade leading to his/her confirmation in that grade on the recommendation of the General Selection Committee.

Provided that the seniority in the case of a teacher, who is confirmed in a grade without being placed on probation, shall be determined from the date of his/her confirmation.

- 2. Seniority among PGT shall be determined from the length of the service as a PGT in the university school:
  - a. Provided that if the date of probationary appointment/confirmation as PGT is same in a AMU School then the teacher who has rendered longest continuous service as PGT in the same school shall be treated as senior.
  - b. Provided further that if the length of service as PGT in that school is also same then the teacher who has rendered longest continuous service as PGT in any school of AMU shall be treated senior.
  - c. Provided further that if the seniority as PGT in a university school is also same then the teacher who has rendered longest continuous service as TGT in same school shall be treated as senior.
  - d. Provided further that if the seniority as PGT and TGT in a university school is also same then the teacher who has rendered longest continuous service as PRT in the same school shall be

treated as senior.

- e. Provided further that the seniority as mentioned above is also same then the teacher who has rendered longest continuous service as TGT in any other school of AMU shall be treated senior.
- f. Provided further that if the seniority as mentioned above is also same then the teacher who has rendered longest continuous service as PRT in the any other university school shall be treated senior.
- 3. Provided further that the service of the teacher as PGT & TGT and PRT in that school is same, the one who is older in age shall be considered senior.
- 4. If a teacher joins University school from some other Government Institution, his/her service shall be transferred as per KVS norms.

- 5. For the purpose of placement in the Senior School/Selection Grade/DPC length of service in that grade shall be considered.
- 6. For the purpose of Pensionary and other benefits, total length of service shall be considered.
- 7. General seniority among teachers shall be maintained from the date of first continuous appointment in any of the AMU school.
