OTHER CONDITIONS:

- 1) If the candidate having two post graduate degrees in different subject in such case marks will be awarded in that particular subjects in which he/she has applied for.
- M.Ed. candidates will be awarded 3 additional marks, with the restriction that marks must not exceed the total marks of 100.
- 3) Additional 3 marks to be awarded to the candidates/applicants for Primary level post if they possess B.Ed. degree in addition to CTET conducted by CBSE/UPTET with restriction that marks must not exceed the total marks of 100.

GUIDELINES FOR SHORT LISTING THE CANDIDATES FOR INTERVIEW:

- a) The University reserves the right to short list the candidates for Interview as per the criteria framed by it from time to time.
- b) It is the responsibility of the candidate to provide all the supporting documents. Evaluation of the candidates will be done on the basis of the documents submitted by the applicant along with his application.
- c) Five (05) eligible candidates will be called for Interview against one advertised Post.
- d) All working candidates in AMU Schools will be called for Interview over and above the shortlisted candidates, if they are not shortlisted otherwise and the candidates must have Teaching Experience of two Academic Sessions in the AMU Schools including current Academic Session. Further, it is also clarified that the appointment made by Selection committee at any point of time during Academic Session including current Academic Session as PGT & PGT-PTT/TGT & TGT-TGT-PTT/PRT & PRT-PTT/PTT, the services rendered will be counted as Academic Session for the purposes of shortlisting the candidate(s) already working in AMU.
- e) The candidate must be teaching in AMU Schools as PGT & PGT-PTT/TGT & TGT-TGT-PTT/PRT & PRT-PTT/PTT and has same requisite qualifications as advertised.
- f) Permanent AMU School teachers selected through GSC and desirous of switching post will also be considered as working candidates.
- g) The shortlisting of the candidates will be done by a committee comprising of the following or as decided by the Competent Authority from time to time:
 - 1) Director, Directorate of School Education or his nominee
 - 2) Principal of the concerned School
 - 3) Four (04) teachers to be appointed by the Director, Directorate of School Education on the recommendation of the Principal of the concerned school, to be the members of the Committee.
